

A By-law to amend By-law 2017-8

A Delegation By-law Being a By-law to establish procurement, service and disposal regulations and policies

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF MARKHAM HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law 2017-8, as amended, is hereby further amended by changes to the table of contents under Part II method of Procurement section to read as follows:

Part II Methods of Procurement

- 5. Request for Tenders (\$133,800 or greater)
- 6. Requests for Proposals (\$133,800 or greater)
- 8. Request for Quotations (between \$25,000 and \$334,400)
- 2. That By-law 2017-8, as amended, is further amended by amending section Part II: Methods of Procurements by increasing dollar thresholds, which reads as follows:

PART II: METHODS OF PROCUREMENT

Request for Tenders (\$133,800 or greater)

5.1 Unless Vendors have been pre-qualified, all Request for Tenders for goods and services over \$133,800 and construction projects over \$334,400 in value will be advertised in a newspaper of general circulation or by electronic media or both.

Requests for Proposals (\$133,800 or greater)

6.1 Unless Vendors have been pre-qualified, all Requests for Proposals for goods and services over \$133,800 and construction projects over \$334,400 ,000 in value shall be advertised in a newspaper of general circulation or by electronic media or both.

Request for Quotations (between \$25,000 and \$334,400)

- 8.1 The City may issue Requests for Quotations for the acquisition of goods and services estimated between \$25,001 and \$133,800 for goods and services or between \$25,001 and \$334,400 for construction projects in value.
- 3. That By-law 2017-8, as amended, is further amended by inserting a new Section 8.4 under Part II Methods of Procurement, which reads as follows:
- 8.4 Where feasible and in the best interest of the City and in compliance with the City's trade agreement obligations, the City will include a requirement or preference for Canadian goods or services.
- 4. All other provisions of By-law 2017-8, as amended, not inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law, shall continue to apply.
