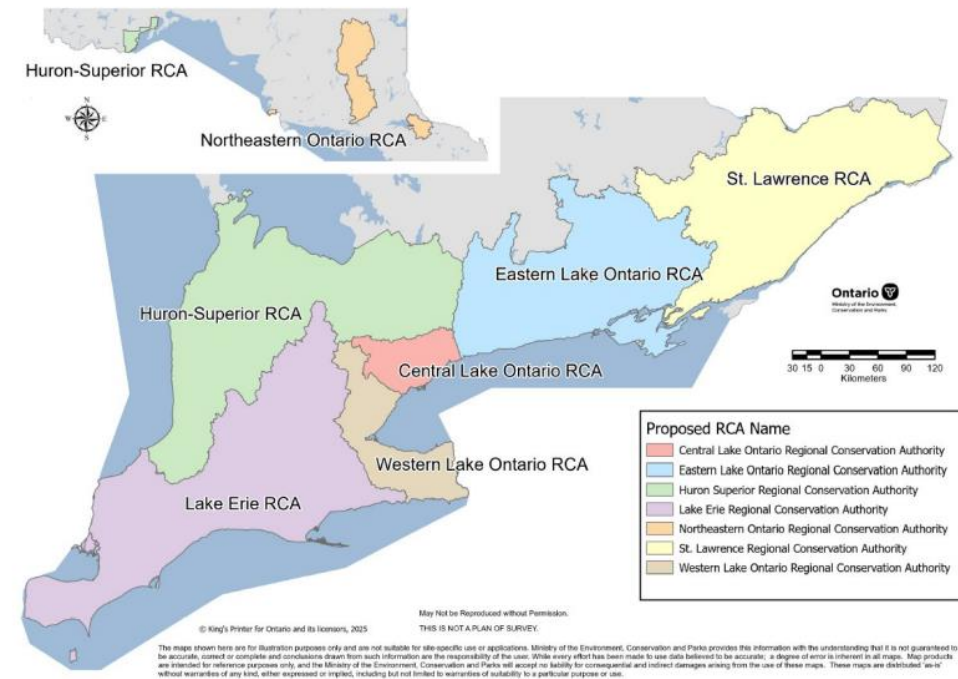


Figure 1 Map of the Proposed Regional Conservation Authorities

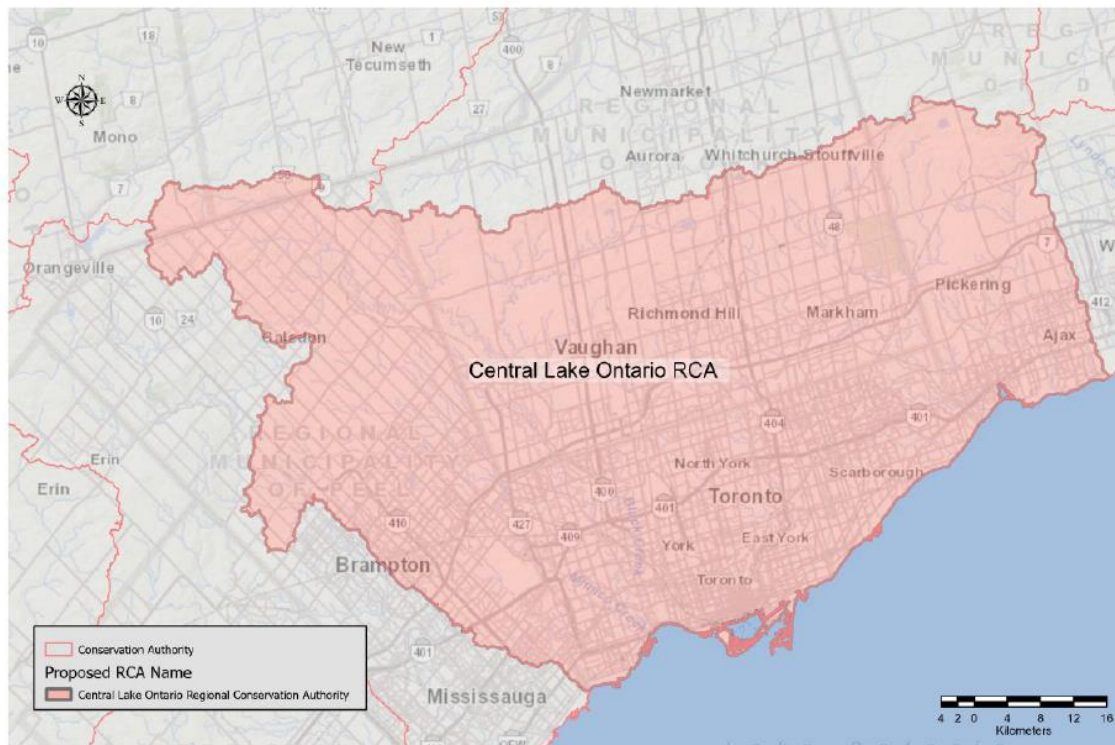


Figure 2 Map of the Proposed Central Lake Ontario Regional Conservation Authority
