Background

- The Markham Pan Am Centre served as one of the venue sites for the T.O. 2015 Pan Am and Para Pan Am Games
- The Markham Pan Am Centre was the third largest project and hosted 4 venues: Badminton, Water Polo, Table Tennis and table tennis competition for 2015 Parapan American Games
- The new sports centre was built in 2014 in partnership with the Pan Am Games with approximately 40% funding from Federal/Provincial Governments
- Markham's Sport Development Plan was approved by Council in 2017.


