PURPOSE:

This report provides a quarterly update of the Street and Park Name Reserve List for the first quarter of 2020.

BACKGROUND:

The Director of Planning and Urban Design has the delegated authority to assign street names from the City's street and park name reserve list to draft plans of subdivision, subject to staff providing the Development Services Committee with a quarterly updated street and park name reserve list indicating newly proposed street and park names, for approval.

It includes all previously approved names that are either still available for use, or have been reserved, but not used. Additional names proposed during the first quarter of 2020 are indicated in the "New Additions" column. Certain names have been deleted from the previous list to reflect names taken from the reserve list and applied to new streets or parks through recent plan registrations. The origin of names in the reserve list is indicated in the "Source" column. The general locations of names are identified in the "Ward" column when known.
