5. Presentation by York Regional Police – Hate Crimes & Incidents

Detective Zabi Aryaie addressed the Committee to make a presentation entitled, Hate Crimes & Incidents.

After the presentation, there was a Q&A and discussion period that addressed the following:

- YRP initiatives to address racism and hate crimes;
- Participation in various community events;
- Perception of incidents and similarities between them to assess appropriate approach to address and act on them;
- The pause of school resource officer programs;
- Scholarship Awards and other initiatives focusing on racialized youth;
- The upcoming YRP Hate Crime Report and 51 recommendations from community consultations will be made public after the meeting on Wednesday April 14, 2021;
- Training requirements of YRP staff;
- Inclusive policing and strategy with respect to recruitment and training of sworn and civilian members.
- Rights and responsibilities in understanding roles in the community;
- The process to file a complaint against policing service www.OIPRD.ON.CA;
- Current trends with respect to race relations preventing crimes and hate crimes,

Alicia Lauzon provided a brief update with respect to data collection and that a working group has been established in this regard.

The Committee requested that additional information be provided on diversity in the workforce in YRP and what training the officers complete to prevent race incidents at a future Race Relations Committee meeting.
