



BY-LAW 2021-35

TO AMEND BYLAW 2018-77 (BEING A BY-LAW TO ADDRESS IN-FILL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES)

WHEREAS Section 11(2)6 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended ("Municipal Act") provides that a municipality may pass by-laws in the interest of the health, safety and well-being of its residents; and,

AND WHEREAS section 128 of the Municipal Act provides that a local Municipality may prohibit and regulate with respect to public nuisances, including matters that, in the opinion of Council, are or could become or cause public nuisances; and,

AND WHEREAS administrative amendments are required from time to time for enforcement purposes;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF MARKHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) That Section 9.0 (Offences) of By-law 2018-77 (being a By-law to address Construction Activities) be amended as follows:
 - (a) By adding Section 9.4:
Every person who contravenes any provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as provided for by the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.33, as amended.
