



Maximum Height C.G.D. of any part of any building	
1	209m C.G.D.
2	302m C.G.D.
3	269m C.G.D.

The following provisions shall apply:

The maximum heights identified in areas 1, 2 and 3 above is measured to the highest point of the roof structure or the parapet, whichever is the greater. The following elements are permitted to project above the maximum heights identified in areas 1, 2 and 3 above:

- elevator overruns, mechanical penthouse, mechanical equipment and any associated enclosure structures to a maximum of 7.0 metres
- parapets, fences, guard rails, railings and dividers, eaves, screens, stairs, vents and architectural features to a maximum of 3.0 metres

# SCHEDULE "E6" TO BY-LAW

## AMENDING BY-LAW 2004-196 DATED

 BOUNDARY OF AREA COVERED BY THIS SCHEDULE

For the purposed of this by-law, established grade shall mean an elevation of 174.66 metres Canadian Geodetic Datum (C.G.D.).
