Additional amenities were suggested such as overhead coverings or designated waiting areas. Options for more ramps or elevator where there are stairs. Explanation of way-finding feature. Committee was encouraged to reach out to Regan and Alain with more feedback after today's meeting.
3. Land Acknowledgment	Michelle Del Carmen shared a presentation on the history behind Indigenous Land Acknowledgments. Michelle suggested two recommendations to add to our City's Land Acknowledgment:
