## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

BY-LAW NO: 2022-5

Part Lot Control Exemption By-law **2753129 Ontario Inc.**Part of Block 2 on Registered Plan 65M-4289 168 Old Kennedy Road

The proposed by-law applies to a 0.49 ha (1.46 ac) property located on the west side of Old Kennedy Road, south of Aldergrove Drive, municipally known as 168 Old Kennedy Road.

The purpose of this by-law is to exempt the subject property from the part lot control provisions of the Ontario *Planning Act*.

The effect of this by-law is to establish an access easement in favour of the adjacent property to the south, municipally known 146 Old Kennedy Road. A similar access easement over the 146 Old Kennedy Road lands will also be provided in favour of the 168 Old Kennedy Road lands through a separate application for improved circulation and serviceability for both properties.
