  - a. Quick Update on Current Renovation

### b. Clean up at BGCC

#### c. Financial Update

   2022 meeting we will come back to this topic
- Shahab asked if he should make holds for residents asking to rent in Jan 2022, but Jeremiah said not yet because we don't have an opening date yet from Colby
- Nimisha (on behalf of BGC) reached out to City regarding seniors trying to print out their vaccine passport
- Idea is to have a drive thru service in community centre parking lot where seniors can come and get help
- We could have translators to help with communication

- We can set up laminators and printers to print out the passports, laminate them and give them to seniors
- Nimisha has sent in a request to the City and will let us know what the response is
- Shawn mentioned issue of access to power from community centre when construction is still going
- Nimisha will think about a backup location
