Dear Mr. Lyons and Ms. Crompton:

We the undersigned have a great interest in the future built form of the Yonge and Royal Orchard area and are sending this letter in response to the Yonge Corridor Land Use and Built Form Study Interim Report.

We believe the Cricklewood lands — situated at the southern end of Inverlochy Blvd. and within the Royal Orchard Station Study Area — should be considered for redevelopment and rezoning at the appropriate time.

This is a large site (55 condominium town homes on approximately 5 acres), which provides opportunities for significantly increased density while allowing for a graduated interface with the existing residential community to the east. Redevelopment to higher densities (high/midrise) would complement the proposed plan on lands along Inverlochy to the north of Cricklewood, while also seamlessly meshing with the existing apartment buildings northwest of Cricklewood.

The Ladies' Golf Club of Toronto to the south and a small park to the west of Cricklewood provide further ability to integrate more intensive development within the general area with no compatibility issues. Also, thoughtful planning could integrate the heritage property at 54 Cricklewood Cres.

The Cricklewood site is within 500m of the future Royal Orchard subway station and offers an opportunity to generate additional housing opportunities within walking distances of the station. Higher density redevelopment would better support the major investment in both the Yonge North Subway Extension and the recent decision to build the Royal Orchard station by providing additional ridership and use. This is particularly supportive of the public investment and in the public interest since large portions of the area within 500m of the station are not proposed for redevelopment or increased density.

We request that any planning for the area consider this important opportunity and are pleased to discuss it further.
