### Bridge Station TOC Update

- Provincial Open House (December 2021)
- Markham Council resolutions:
  - Do not support TOC and requested withdrawal (January 2022)
  - Requested Province to comprehensively plan area and undertake Blue-Sky Planning Exercise (March 2022)
- Staff met with Province regularly since January 2022 to advance direction






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#### Bridge Station TOC Update - Continued

- Province issued enhanced Minister's Zoning Order (eMZO) (April 14, 2022)
- Province announced Royal Orchard subway station (April 20, 2022)
- Provincial response to Markham Council resolutions (April 8, 2022) resulted in no direct change to the TOC

#### Agreements

- Province proposing two TOC Agreements with municipalities:
  - Program Agreement-in-Principle to confirm broad approach for implementing Bridge, High Tech, and potential future TOCs along subway in York Region
  - 2. Site-Specific Memorandum of Understanding for detailed implementation on Bridge Station TOC





#### **Next Steps**

- Province seeking:
  - Program level agreement in principal to be executed by end of April 2022
  - Site-Specific Memorandum of Understanding to be executed within 6-9 months
