



By-law 2022-94

A by-law to dedicate certain lands as
part of the highways of the City of Markham →

The Town of Markham was established by The Regional Municipality of York Act, effective January 1, 1971.


The Corporation of the Town of Markham has changed its name to The Corporation of the City of Markham by By-law No. 2012-120 enacted and passed May 29, 2012, effective July 1, 2012, as evidenced in Instrument No. YR1847438 registered June 29, 2012.

WHEREAS Part Lot 6 Block B Plan 18; Part Lot 7 Block B Plan 18; Part Mill Street Plan 173 Lying south of Lot 32 Block M Plan 173; and Part west ½ Lot 9 Concession 8 (Travelled Road), being Mill Street East of Markham Road and north of Rouge Street were conveyed to the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York for public use.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham enacts as follows:

1. THAT FIRSTLY, Part Lot 6 Block B Plan 18; Part Lot 7 Block B Plan 18; Part Mill Street Plan 173 Lying south of Lot 32 Block M Plan 173; and SECONDLY, Part west ½ Lot 9 Concession 8 (Travelled Road), being Mill Street East of Markham Road and north of Rouge Street in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York are hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Mill Street.

Read a first, second, and third time and passed on July 14, 2022.
