**7. DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

C. Molloy gave a report. Wendy has initiated a plan to add an electronic sign to the front of the Museum. Currently waiting on approval from the Mayor. There is interest in the Acadia train car from a local foundation. Dan Jones met with tree inspectors who have determined that eight trees on site are dead and need to come down. Two furnaces need replacing in Church and Chapman, and there is encouragement to install heat pumps, which are more efficient but more complicated. The geothermal system in the Collections Building has issues. Andrea Carpenter is working on rewriting programs based around the new school curriculum around colonization and reconciliation. Pottery programs are still selling out. There is a Pat Wheeler focused exhibition in the works now, which will replace "What is Markham?" in the south gallery. The Collections Committee will meet for the first time since before the pandemic, on October 17. The Friends purchased a set of play foam blocks for the Museum's children's activities using the grant funding.

The Chair gave a report. Lots of activity. Matthew is working on the reconciliation of the grant, and we should see funds coming back to us soon. There is a donation kiosk which we are working on getting; we have hired an artist to create the design that will be shown on the screen. Meeting with Anna and Sue tomorrow about a marketing strategy for the holidays related to the notecards and books.

Current bank balance is \$75,866.24, including \$9588 from the grant.
