5. Committee and Sub-Committee Updates

DEI Office Update

Ms. Baker introduced guest speaker, Shervin Ghaem-Maghami, PHD Candidate at U o T, who addressed the Committee to introduce his research on community planning and engagement, from the perspective of immigrants and municipalities. Mr. Ghaem-Maghami will evaluate how the planning policies and decisions are made in a municipality in an effort to create a greater sense of belonging and inclusion in communities. His research will focus on 5 municipalities, including Markham. Mr. Ghaem-Maghami noted the uniqueness of the City's Diversity Action Plan (DAP).

Chasidy Palmer presented, Street Naming Practices and Procedures, which provided an overview of naming conventions, factors of consideration and policy development of other municipalities. She noted the importance of history and sharing of information to promote awareness to the significance and potential conflicts surrounding a name. This information may be used to establish a policy at the City in the future.
