4. LITTLE NATIVE HOCKEY LEAGUE BID TO HOST - 2024 TOURNAMENT, CULTURAL FESTIVAL AND GALA CELEBRATION

Arvin Prasad, Commissioner of Development Services provided opening remarks relative to the Little Native Hockey League.

Mary Creighton, Director of Recreation delivered a PowerPoint presentation regarding Little Native Hockey League Bid to Host, 2024 Tournament, Cultural Festival and Gala Celebration.

1. That the report entitled Little Native Hockey League Bid to Host – 2024 Tournament, Cultural Festival and Gala Celebration be received; and

- 2. That Council approve the City's In-Kind contribution currently estimated at \$360,000 as outlined in the report, to be managed within existing City budgets; and,
- 3. That Council approve that the Board of Directors of Destination Markham Corporation (DMC) provide direct financial support in the amount of up to \$500,000 and a direct in-kind support of \$50,000 (this can be adjusted based on the staff involvement) if the City of Markham and DMC are successful in winning the bid to host the Little Native Hockey League Tournament; and,
- 4. That Council authorize staff on behalf of the Corporation to submit a Bid to host the 2024 Little Native Hockey League Tournament, Cultural Festival and Gala Celebration; and further,
- 5. That Staff be authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to this resolution.
