SUBJECT:	2024 Interim Spending Authority Pending Adoption of the 2024 Budget

RECOMMENDATION:

- 1. That the report titled "2024 Interim Spending Authority Pending Adoption of the 2024 Budget", be received; and
- THAT Council provide the Treasurer authority to make payments necessary to support the City's ongoing operations, up to a total of 50% of the City's 2023 Primary Operating, Waterworks, Planning & Design, Building Standards, and Engineering budgets (\$222,357,599); and
- 3. THAT Staff be authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to this resolution.

PURPOSE:

To obtain Council approval for the Treasurer to make payments necessary to support the ongoing business of the City, prior to the adoption of the 2024 budget.

BACKGROUND:

This is an annual administrative report, usually tabled for Committee's consideration around October in anticipation of the following budget year, which seeks Council approval for interim spending authority. This interim spending authority will enable staff to make payments required for the City's operations and services to continue, without interruption and at existing approved service levels, as a new year begins and until the City's budget for the new year is adopted.

Consistent with previous approvals, 2024 Interim Spending Authority of up to 50% of the City's 2023 approved budgets for operating expenditures is being requested.

All expenditures for goods and services will conform to existing by-laws and policies.
