Hello, my name is Ben Snaper and as a member of the community I would like to raise some concerns and opinions on the new Hilton Towers and Public Parks going to the south west corner of Warden and Highway 7.

There is a desperate need for Pet Owners to have a designated area (Dog Park) to let pets have a space where they can be off leash. Currently there are no parks within walking distance of the area that allow such activities and creates a problem for pet owners.
