Property/Building Description: 2 storey, non-heritage building

Use: Commercial

Heritage Status: Designated under Part V of the Ontario Heritage Act, and

identified as a Class 'C' building, or buildings that do not

relate to the heritage character of the district.

Application Proposal

• The owner proposes to use the ground floor of the building for a Cycling Training Centre.

Background

The subject property was formerly used as a local branch of the Royal Bank.

Staff Comment

• The proposed use will have no impact on the appearance of the building or the character of the existing historic character of the district other than through signage. Therefore, Heritage Staff recommends that Heritage Markham provide no comment on the proposed use from a heritage perspective.

Suggested Recommendation for Heritage Markham


