Dear Members of Council,

I am writing in support of Item 8.1.11 Traffic Calming on Carlton Road between Kennedy and McCowan. We are a family to two school age children and live in close proximity to the Carlton/Waterbridge Lane intersection. Vehicle speeds on Carlton are way too high for a local street lined with single family homes. The real-life operating speeds feel more like 60 – 70km/h and the road has curves and changes in elevation that make it difficult to see the many pedestrians, dog walkers, cyclist that use this road. Reducing speeds is a must to improve safety for the community.

Please also continue to allow street parking on all parts of Carlton. We need that flexibility for the various service providers that serve an aging community.

I agree with Staff's recommended traffic calming design that will result in improved safety for residents living directly on Carlton Road, the local community and all road users of the corridor.
