



By-law 2016-15

A by-law to dedicate certain lands as
part of the highways of the City of Markham

The Corporation of the Town of Markham has changed its name to The Corporation of the City of Markham by By-law No. 2012-120 enacted and passed May 29, 2012, effective July 1, 2012, as evidenced in Instrument No. YR1847438 registered June 29, 2012.

Whereas Blocks 233 and 234, Plan 65M-3799 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York were conveyed to The Corporation of the City of Markham for public use;

And Whereas Blocks 26 and 27, Plan 65M-4450 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York were conveyed to The Corporation of the City of Markham for public use:

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Block 233, Plan 65M-3799 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Cheswick Court.
2. That Block 234, Plan 65M-3799 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Warton Court.
3. That Block 26, Plan 65M-4450 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Warton Court.
4. That Block 27, Plan 65M-4450 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Cheswick Court.
