

## By-law 2015-112

A by-law to dedicate certain lands as part of the highways of the City of Markham

The Corporation of the Town of Markham has changed its name to The Corporation of the City of Markham by By-law No. 2012-120 enacted and passed May 29, 2012, effective July 1, 2012, as evidenced in Instrument No. YR1847438 registered June 29, 2012.

Whereas Part of Lots 1 and 2, Concession 8, designated Blocks 103, 111 and 112, Plan 65M-3530 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York were conveyed to The Corporation of the City of Markham for public use;

And Whereas Parts of Lots 1, 2 and 3, Concession 8, designated as Blocks 5 and 6, Plan 65M-3616 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York was conveyed to The Corporation of the City of Markham for public use;

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Part of Lots 1 and 2, Concession 8, designated as Block 111, 65M-3530 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Eastvale Drive.
- 2. That Part of Lots 1, 2 and 3, Concession 8, designated as Block 7, Plan 65M-3616, in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Eastvale Drive.
- 3. That Part of Lots 1 and 2, Concession 8, designated as Blocks 103 and 112, Plan 65M-3530, in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Ferncliffe Crescent.
- 4. That Part of Lots 1, 2 and 3, Concession 8, designated as Blocks 5 and 6, Plan 65M-3616, in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Elson Street.

Read a first, second, and third time and passed on June 23, 2015.
