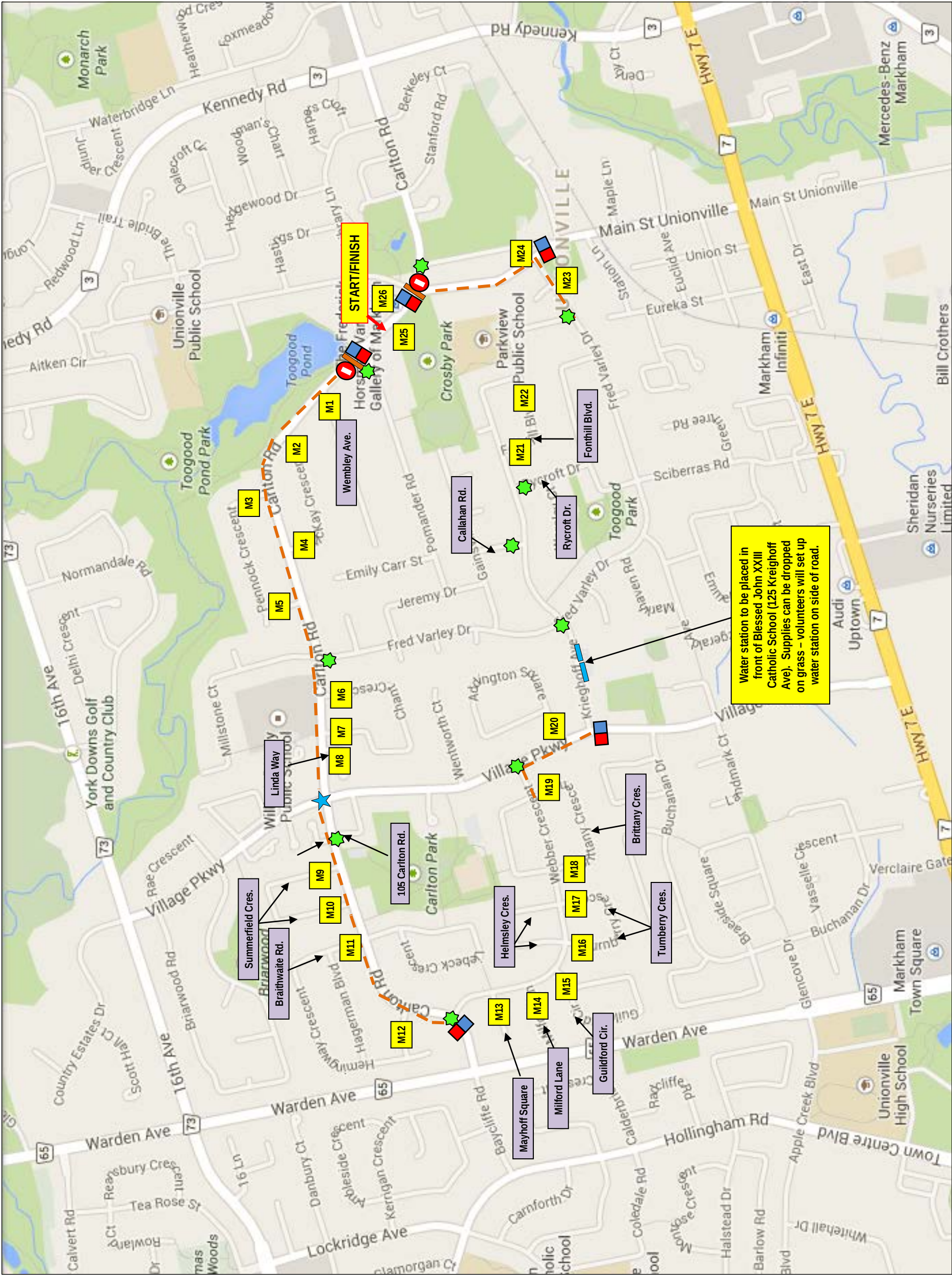

 - Vehicles travelling east on Pomander Rd. will be diverted north on Carlton Rd.
 - Vehicles travelling east on Carlton Rd. will be diverted west on Pomander Rd.
 - Vehicles travelling west on Carlton will be diverted north/south on Main St.
- 8:00am:** Paid duty officers, auxiliary officers and volunteer marshals in place
- 8:30am:** Girls 1k begins on Carlton Rd.
- 8:45am:** 10k race begins
- 9:00am:** 5k race begins
- 5k runners will complete one loop of the course.
10k runners will complete two loops of the course.
