



By-law 2014-126

A by-law to amend By-Law 4-2000, as amended, to delegate authority under the Municipal Act to the Chief Administrative Officer


Whereas Section 23.1 (1) of the *Municipal Act* S.O 2001, c, as amended, provides that a municipal council may delegate its powers and duties under the Municipal Act to officers or employees of the municipality; and,

Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham has enacted By-law 4-2000 to appoint a Chief Administrative Officer responsible for the management of administrative aspects of the City;


Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the following be added to By-law 4-2000, as amended, as Section 4.2:
 - 4.2 For the purpose of this By-law, "election recess" shall mean the days between the last regular Council meeting before voting day in a municipal election, as defined by the **Municipal Elections Act 1996, S.O. 1996, c.32**, and the next regular Council meeting after voting day. For clarity, a municipal election shall not include a by-election as defined in the said Act.
2. That the following sections of By-law 4-2000, as amended, be amended as follows:
 - a) Section 5 be amended to add the words "and election recess" after the words "summer recess" in the last line thereof.
 - b) Section 6 be amended to add the words "and election recess" after the words "summer recess" in the last line thereof.
 - c) Section 6.2 be amended to add the words "and election recess" after the words "summer recess period" in the first line thereof.
3. That this By-law shall come into force and effect from the date of its passage by the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham.

Read a first, second, and third time and passed on September 10, 2014.
