

By-law 2014-99

To amend Bylaw 2002-94 being a bylaw to prohibit and regulate signs and other advertising devices and the posting of notices on buildings or vacant lots within the City of Markham.

(Sign By-law)

Whereas Section 11(2)5 of the <u>Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001.C.25</u> as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws in the interest of economic, social and environmental well-being of a municipality; and,

Whereas Section 11(3)7 of the <u>Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001.C.25</u> as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws respecting signs; and,

Whereas Sections 99(1), (2) and (3) of the <u>Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001.C.25</u> as amended, provide that a municipality may pass by-laws respecting advertising devices;

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham enacts as follows:

- (A) That Sign Bylaw 2002-94, Section 4.7. (Prohibited Signs) be amended as follows:
- 1) Sub-section 4.7.1 be amended as follows:

Sub-section 4.7.1 be deleted in its entirety:

"Any sign not expressly permitted by this By-law is prohibited and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the following signs are specifically prohibited:"

and replace it with the following new Sub-section 4.7.1

"Any sign not expressly permitted by this By-law is prohibited and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the following signs are specifically prohibited save and except for those signs approved by the Council of the City."

Read a first, second, and third time and passed on June 24, 2014.
