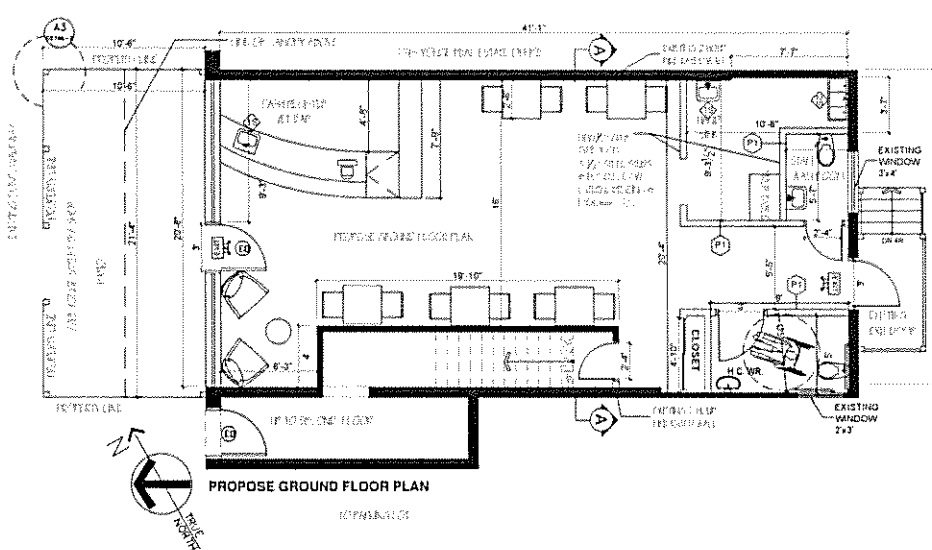

Basket tossing bruises the edges and exposes the leaf's enzymes to oxygen initiating oxidation. Oxidation is the process that results in the flavour profiles of Oolong and Black Tea. White Tea Silver Tips

White tea is made with leaves that are processed in a manner to let them wilt slightly and lose the 'grassy' taste of most Green tea, while undergoing minimal oxidation. The buds and leaves used in White tea are often younger, resulting in a higher amount of caffeine than Green teas. Enjoy some of this healthy, original blend from the Chinese province of Fujian.

Golden Tea

Dianhong tea is a type of Chinese black tea, used as a relatively high end gourmet black tea and sometimes used in various tea blends. The main difference between Dianhong and other Chinese black teas is the amount of fine leaf buds, or "golden tips," present in the dried tea. Fermented with lychee, rose and longan, Dianhong teas produces a brew that is brassy golden orange in colour with a sweet, gentle aroma and no astringency.

Cheaper varieties of Dianhong produce a darker brownish brew that can be very bitter.

Black Tea with Spices and Herbs

Cardamom

An aromatic spice indigenous to South India and Sri Lanka. Cardamom seeds come from a plant belonging to the ginger family.

Saffron

Saffron is a spice derived from the flower of *Crocus sativus*, commonly known as the saffron crocus. *Crocus* is a genus in the family Iridaceae.

Cinnamon

Cinnamon is a spice obtained from the inner bark of several trees from the genus *Cinnamomum* that is used in both sweet and savoury foods.

Ginger

Ginger or ginger root is the rhizome of the plant *Zingiber officinale*. Consumed as a delicacy, medicine or spice, it lends its name to its genus and family. Other notable members of this plant family are turmeric, cardamom, and galangal.

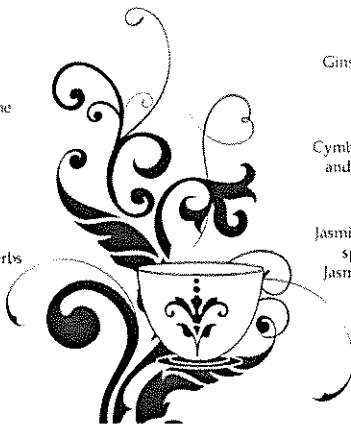
The rose hip, also known as rose haw or rose hep, is the fruit of the rose plant that typically is red-to-orange, but ranges from dark purple to black in some species

Jasmine is a genus of shrubs and vines in the olive family. It contains around 200 species native to tropical and warm temperate regions of the Old World. Jasmynes are widely cultivated for the characteristic fragrance of their flowers.
