

BY-LAW 2013-193

A by-law to dedicate certain lands as part of the highways of the City of Markham

The Corporation of the Town of Markham has changed its name to The Corporation of the City of Markham by By-law No. 2012-120 enacted and passed May 29, 2012, effective July 1, 2012, as evidenced in Instrument No. YR1847438 registered June 29, 2012.

WHEREAS Blocks 21 and 22, Plan 65M-4258, in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York were conveyed to The Corporation of the City of Markham for public use;

AND WHEREAS Blocks 19, 20 and 22, Plan 65M-4400, in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York were conveyed to The Corporation of the City of Markham for public use;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF MARKHAM HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT Block 21, Plan 65M-4258, City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named LANE.
- 2. THAT Block 22, Plan 65M-4258, City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named IAN BARON AVENUE.
- 3. THAT Blocks 19 and 20, Plan 65M-4400, City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York are hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named IAN BARON AVENUE.
- 4. THAT Block 22, Plan 65M-4400, City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named LANE.
