

### **Addendum to Council Adopted December 2013 Markham Official Plan Part 1**

In adopting the Markham Official Plan on December 10, 2013, Council passed the following resolution with respect to the Catholic Cemeteries, Archdiocese of Toronto application for redesignation of their lands at 3010 and 3196 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue from 'Future Employment Area' to permit a cemetery use, as shown as a 'Deferral Area' on the excerpt of Map 3 – Land Use attached.

"That consideration of the employment land redesignation application by Catholic Cemeteries be deferred and that staff be directed to work with the applicant to find a mutually agreeable solution to the Catholic Cemeteries requirements on/or before two (2) years from December 10, 2013; and, in the event that staff and Catholic Cemeteries do not arrive at a mutually agreeable solution within said time frame, staff is directed to process the current application OPA/ 13/116842."
