## Notes from fire chief:

"Fire and Emergency Services and the Operations departments do not support the road closure overnight. This was tried last year and the conditions included having the barricades staffed and the organizers did not insure this happened. At 1:15 am I rode my bike down Main Street, at that time there was no staff at the Main and Bullock location, nor several of the side streets running off of Main. (i.e. Wilson, Dublin) Also I stopped outside the Duchess and was speaking with the owner when a car came down Main St, the driver asked how to get off the street, as she was unaware how she got on the closed street and wanted to know how to get off the closed street. I moved the Centre Street barricades and directed her to exit at this location. The barricades not being staffed impact response time for fire as we would have to stop and open the barricade, proceed through and then stop to replace the barricade as we could not leave the street open thereby allowing other vehicles to pass through."

## <u>Ingress / Egress</u>

- Residences of Wilson Street and Water Street can exit the area via Robinson Street West to Hawkridge Ave
- Residences of Dublin Street can exit to Robinson St via parking lots that access Robinson St.
- Residences of Bruce Thompson Crt can exit via Main Street North south to Hwy 7
- Residences North of Mains Mansion and funeral home can exit via Main Street north to Bullock Dr

## Conditions for the overnight closure:

Your community event application has been confirmed under the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Event Organizer(s), volunteers and/or members will provide one lane way from Dixon Garland Funeral Home on Markham Rd to Bullock Drive;
- 2. Event Organizer(s) will provide volunteers to man the barricade(s) on Bullock Drive / Parkway Avenue to allow the Funeral Home Patrons egress and ingress;
- 3. Noise Exemption must end at 2300h:
- 4. York Regional Police Officer(s) must man the <u>intersection of Hwy 7 and Markham Rd</u> at <u>all times</u> during the event road closure; Cost will be incurred by the event organizer(s);
- 5. One adult must maintain all local barricades on Friday at midnight until Saturday 10:00 am;
- Event organizer(s) must provide a minimum of two adults at least 18 years of age for each barricade location(s);
- 7. Minimum two security guards must be provided at the expense of the organizer(s) on Saturday from midnight to 0800h to monitor Markham Road;
- 8. Event Organizer(s) must ensure emergency access is maintained at <u>all times</u>. It is imperative that emergency traffic is allowed through streets and roadways;

- The road right of way must be clear of litter and debris within the 24 hours following the event. Failure to do so will
  result in City staff completing the task at a cost of \$150 per hour (3 hour minimum) with charges being the
  responsibility of the event.
- · Comply with any and all other conditions imposed by the City of Markham and its Departments.

#### One week prior to the event:

- Confirm arrangements for barricades and pylons with the Special Events Coordinator
- Payment of fees for goods and services provided by the City of Markham must be received
- Appropriate approvals
- Provide notification to all affected residences, churches and businesses regarding the date, time and duration of the road(s) closure
- Post signs notifying the public of the road closure and potential traffic delays


