

BY-LAW 2012-238

A by-law to authorize the Use of Internet Voting as an Alternative Voting Method

WHEREAS section 42 of the <u>Municipal Elections Act</u>, S.O. 1996 provides that a municipal council may enact a by-law, authorizing the use of voting and vote counting equipment such as voting machines, voting recorders or optical scanning vote tabulators and other voting methods that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote, on or before June 1 in the year of the election;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Markham enacts as follows:

The use of Internet-Voting is hereby authorized for the purpose of voting during the Early Vote period for the 2014 Municipal Elections.

READ A FIRST, SECOND, AND THIRD TIME AND PASSED THIS 20^{TH} DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2012.
