Re: Additional Information - Funeral, Burial & Cremation Services Act, 2002 - Markham Cemetery By-law

Update

General Committee, at it's meeting on September 10, 2012, requested staff to provide further information in respect to a report entitled "Funeral, Burial & Cremation Services Act, 2002 - Markham Cemetery By-law Update". In response to this request, staff are appending to this memo a revised Attachment "C" and a new Attachment "D" to the report. The revised attachments provide Council with information on all cemeteries within the boundary's of the City. These lists are compiled from the Ministry of Consumer Services list of cemeteries and burial grounds in the Province of Ontario

1. Revised Attachment "C" – List of Cemeteries Owned by the City of Markham

Attachment "C" has been revised to clarify the list of cemeteries for which the City of Markham is the licensed operator. Attachment "C" is amended to divide the list of 21 cemeteries into 4 distinct groups:

Group 1 Cemeteries – are active cemeteries owned, licensed and maintained by the City. Each of these cemeteries has interment rights (i.e. graves) for sale.

Group 2 Cemeteries – are active cemeteries owned, licensed and maintained by the City. Each cemetery is still active for burials only. All interment rights (i.e. graves) have been sold.

Group 3 Cemeteries – are inactive pioneer or abandoned cemeteries, licensed and maintained by the City. These cemeteries were acquired or transferred to the City under provincial legislation requiring municipalities to assume responsibility for maintaining abandoned cemeteries. The City is responsible for maintaining the cemetery grounds and all grave markers.

Group 4 Cemeteries – are abandoned cemeteries (or pioneer burial grounds) for which the City is the licensed operator under provincial legislation requiring municipalities to assume responsibility for maintaining abandoned cemeteries. However, these cemeteries are on land owned by third parties. Those third parties are responsible for maintaining the cemeteries.

All of the Cemeteries in Groups 1, 2 and 3, are subject to any cemetery by-law passed by Council. The Group 4 Cemeteries do not fall under the City's Cemetery By-law as they are on private land.



2. New Attachment "D" - List of Privately or Religiously Owned Cemeteries in Markham

Attachment "D" is a list of all cemeteries within the boundaries of the City of Markham that are owned, operated and maintained as private or religious cemeteries. There are currently 22 privately owned cemeteries. Of these, all but Huber Cemetery are religious cemeteries. Huber Cemetery, is a pioneer cemetery of one grave stone and an undetermined number of burials located on private land. These cemeteries are maintained by the owners of the cemetery or land.

These inactive cemeteries and pioneer burial grounds are owned, licensed and maintained by the City of Markham as required by provincial legislation. There are no internment rights for sale and no burials occurring. The City is responsible for the continuous maintenance of the cemetery lands and grave markers. These cemeteries are subject to the City's Cemetery By-law.

Third parties are responsible (as noted) for maintaining the cemetery lands and grave markers. These cemeteries are small pioneer burial grounds on private lands. These cemeteries are not subject to the City's Cemetery By-law.
