This letter is provided in response to the letter prepared by Loopstra Nixon LLP, dated November 9, 2011.

They indicate that the Aercoustics' noise feasibility study, dated June 8, 2011, did not address the night-time period or the proposed Phase 2 development of the church (i.e. the warehouse portion).

With this, it is inferred that the noise mitigation recommendations proposed by Aercoustics for the Phase 1 development of the church are considered acceptable.

Aercoustics has been requested to conduct a noise feasibility study for the proposed Phase 2 church development. This will also address use during the night-time period.

It is expected that with the implementation of mitigation proposed for Phase 1, i.e. all activity restricted to the building interior and the exclusive use of sealed nonoperable windows, the proposed Phase 2 can be accommodated with these same controls.

These should not affect Holcim's CofA noise control requirements.
