PURPOSE:

The purpose of this report is to obtain approval on the proposed meeting dates for:

- 1) 2019 Budget; and
- 2) 2019 Water & Wastewater Rate.

BACKGROUND:

The 2019 Budget process will include six Budget Committee meetings that will be held in January and February 2019. In addition, input will be sought through a public meeting to be held on February 21, 2019 at the Civic Centre. Staff will incorporate feedback from the public meeting into the report to Council. It is proposed that a Council decision on the 2019 Budget will be made on March 19, 2019. A press conference will take place on March 20, 2019.

The 2019 water & wastewater rate will be discussed at General Committee on January 21, 2019. A public meeting will be held on February 5, 2019 at the Civic Centre. Staff will incorporate feedback from the public meeting into the report to Council on February 26, 2019. The new rate will be effective April 1, 2019.

OPTIONS/ DISCUSSION:

Markham is focused on effective fiscal management and operational excellence to ensure sustainability of our City for the future.

1. 2019 Budget

Staff commenced the 2019 Budget in March 2018 with the annual Life Cycle Reserve Study update. The goal is to determine if there are sufficient funds in the Life Cycle Replacement & Capital Reserve Fund at the end of the 25-year period. Details of the 2018 update will be provided at the first Budget Committee meeting on January 18, 2019.

Preliminary operating and capital budgets were developed with consideration of items such as the departmental business plans, Life Cycle Reserve Study, Development Charges Background Study and an economic scan which was a forecast of items that may have a financial impact on the budget such as collective agreements, inflation, interest rate and legislative changes.

A comprehensive review of budget was conducted by Staff, Commissioners and the CAO prior to being presented to the Budget Committee.

1c. Paperless Capital Budget

On-line access to capital request forms was implemented in 2013 to align with the paperless agenda initiative. The process of accessing 2019 capital request forms on-line will be provided to Members of Council on Wednesday January 2, 2019. Training will be provided, if required, prior to the Budget deliberation process.

Capital Budget binders will only be provided on an exception basis, and requests can be made to Andrea Tang by Monday, December 17, 2018.

2. 2019 Water & Wastewater Rate

Markham owns and operates the water distribution and wastewater collection systems, and purchases water supply and wastewater treatment from the Region. The Region purchases water from the City of Toronto and Region of Peel.

The 2019 water & wastewater rate will be discussed at General Committee on January 21, 2019. A public meeting will be held on February 5, 2019 at the Civic Centre. Staff will incorporate feedback from the public meeting into the report to Council on February 26, 2019. The new rate will be effective April 1, 2019.
