COLLECTIONS MANAGEMENT BRIEF
March 21, 2018

The Collections Management Committee met on March 21, 2018 for review of artifacts selected for deaccession from the collection of Markham Museum, that will be presented to the City of Markham through the Friends of Markham Museum.

The committee also reviewed artifacts slated for inclusion into the archives.

Artifacts for Discussion:

Members of the committee were presented by museum staff with a comprehensive list of artifacts from the Strickler Barn – Main Floor and Loft, Kinee Barn, Koch-Burkholder Carriage House and the Collections Building that are slated for deaccession (indicated by “NO” pass). These assessed artifacts were discussed individually in detail by committee members and museum staff to ascertain that the items should be deaccessioned. The list also includes artifacts that are to remain within the collection.
