PURPOSE:

The purpose of this report is to request approval for business travel for Sandra Tam, Senior Business Development Officer to Wuhan, China from April 8 to 14 to participate in the "Seminar for Officials from Wuhan's International Friendly Cities" hosted by the Foreign Affairs Office of Wuhan Municipal Government. The objective of the seminar is to exchange best practices and to learn from international experts how to accelerate local economic growth through global collaboration. The seminar will strengthen Markham's international partnership for economic development to build a Global Markham as per "Markham 2020" Economic Strategy.

OPTIONS/ DISCUSSION:

Markham-Wuhan Relations:

Markham's Economic Alliance Program aims at creating "a global network of business relations with communities and business groups in strategic market locations and to create an international awareness of Markham's business assets and geographic benefits." One of Markham's most successful economic alliances is with Wuhan, Hubei Province, China. The strategic alliance has evolved since 2000 when a memorandum of

understanding was signed, and the two cities officially became "Sister Cities" when a twinning agreement was signed in 2006. In October 2016, Markham celebrated the 10th anniversary of Markham-Wuhan sister city relations by hosting a successful Canada-China Investment Forum, an official MOU signing ceremony and a cultural night celebration attended by more than 300 Markham and Wuhan business and cultural leaders.

The frequent and regular exchanges and communication between Markham and Wuhan over the past years resulted in significant Wuhan investment in Markham. Recent examples include a mixed use real estate project and the expansion of a local international school.

The Seminar for Officials from Wuhan's International Friendly Cities, April 8-14, Wuhan, Hubei Province, China

The Seminar for Officials from Wuhan's International Friendly Cities is hosted by the Foreign Affairs Office of Wuhan Municipal Government, with the aim of sharing successful experiences and exploring future collaboration among economic development colleagues globally. It also provides an opportunity for government foreign affairs officials, industry leaders and managers in the field of international economic development to build useful business relations and to exchange knowledge and ideas.

Wuhan has sent invitations to colleagues from its 107 international friendship cities' Foreign Affairs Office or Economic Development Department to participate in the seminar. Cities invited from North America include Markham, San Francisco, Chicago and Pittsburgh. Markham is Wuhan's only sister city in Canada, and similarly, Markham's only sister city in China is Wuhan. As such, a special invitation was sent to Sandra Tam, Senior Business Development Officer to represent Markham, Canada at the seminar (Attachment A).

The Wuhan Municipal Government will cover the participants' expenditure for accommodation, local transportation and training expenses during the seminar in Wuhan. Participants are responsible for his/her international travel expenses and expenses for personal purposes.

Markham staff have been invited to similar events in the past, such as the "International Training Workshop on Technological Innovation for SMEs Based on Science and Technology" conducted by Zhongguancun Science Park in Beijing, China in 2011, and the "Belt and Road Summit" in Hong Kong in 2016. Markham's participation in both events has resulted in positive outcomes which include strengthening of business links and promoting Markham as the preferred destination for investment.

Benefits for Markham to Participate in the Seminar

- 1. It is an excellent opportunity to showcase Markham as the high-tech capital of Canada and to promote Markham's strong high-tech and knowledge-based business sectors.
- 2. It helps strengthen ties with Markham's strategic partners in China, with a special focus in building useful business relations in the fields of advanced technologies

and environmental sustainability.

- 3. It fosters and builds effective global connections, which may lead to increased investment and trade opportunities for Markham.
- 4. Staff gain the benefit of learning from experts about China's current and future social and economic trends and government policies, so as to help build a prosperous and sustainable Markham.
