1. Call to Order

2. Storm Water Fees on Farm Properties Presentation

Robert Muir, Mark Visser & Shane Manson were in attendance to provide a presentation entitled Storm Water Fees on Farm Properties. Robert advised that the presentation is intended to provided on overview on the flood control program. He indicated that the purpose of the presentation is to discuss the flood controlling aspects of farm land. Currently only 206 different lands classified as farm land according to the Ministry of Agriculture and Natural Resources.

Discussion ensued on the various methods municipalities use to calculate run-off. It was noted that Current Value Assessment has been used by many other municipalities and countries as a fair and equitable manner of collecting fees.
