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Background

- Markham was invited by the Confederation of Greater Toronto Chinese Business Association (CGTCBA) to lead the 2015 Trade Mission to China in November/December, 2015.
- Business mission is an integral part of the City's 10-Year Economic Strategy "Markham 2020" and to building of "Global Markham" and "Branded Markham".
- Developing "business to business" and "government to government" links enhances market growth opportunities and increases Markham's attraction of foreign direct investment.



Mission Outcomes

Strengthened economic ties and promoted cultural exchanges

- Memorandum of Understanding signed between Markham and Nanhai on Cooperation in the year of 2016 in the areas of:
 - business exchanges;
 - 23rd World Overseas Chinese Cantonese Opera Culture Festival;
 - Markham-Nanhai-Shunde Food Festival
- Met Wuhan Mayor and discussed plans to celebrate 10th Anniversary of Markham Wuhan Sister City Relations

Raised Markham profile in China:

 - **Jiangmen, Guangdong:**
Located in the newly developed Central Business District, **Jiangmen Binjiang New City:** 1,621 m. long, 25 m wide, first street in Jiangmen named after a non-Chinese city.

Raised Markham profile in China cont'd:

- **Nanhai District, Foshan City, Guangdong:**
“Information Road” renamed “Markham Road”: located in centre of Foshan National Hi-Tech Industrial Zone and Shishan College Town, campus of 3 universities with 38,000 students, 3 kms long.

Mission Outcomes

Yielded business leads and opportunities for Markham businesses, examples:

- SmartRay established business relations with a 3D metal printer manufacturer.
- SmartRay connected with a supplier in Shenzhen, estimated purchase value of 2 million in 2016.
- Merit Education, a Markham education institution, entered into partnership with Hong Shun Group to establish “Merit Education Learning Centre” in Wuhan.
- A Markham delegate is planning to consolidate its operation and to expand in Markham.



Mission Outcomes

Encouraged business exchange which leads to potential investment in Markham:

- Cybernaut, CRCC, CleNET, DJI, Kangmei, - companies planning overseas investments expressed interests in Markham business opportunities.
- A high-level Wuhan East Lake Hi-Tech Development Zone Delegation is visiting Markham in March, 2016 to scout potential for investing in Markham.
- Nanhai Foreign Affairs Office is coordinating with Markham Economic Development Office to plan a trade and investment delegation to Markham in Fall, 2016.
- Generated interests in Markham's hi-tech and business park; resulted meetings with a high-tech company, a Markham based higher education institute and a Hong Kong based asset management company.





Post-Mission Survey Results

~ 69% responded: 18 respondents out of net 26 participants.

- **Meet Delegation objectives:**

100% of surveyed participants answered “yes” to the question

“Did the Trade Mission meet your objectives and to what extent?”

Comments:

- “Yes, this mission indeed expanded my horizon through the social networking perspectives.
It inspires me to seek more business opportunities.”
- “For the part that I attended, I was exposed to potential opportunities that could help my Markham based business grow.”
- “I participated in the Mission in order to get a better sense of the PRC and specifically what was happening with the development of Eco-Cities in China.”

Post-Mission Survey Results

- Mission improves company competitiveness:

100% of surveyed participants answered “yes” to the question

“Did the Trade Mission provide you with new information or contacts that could improve and/or expand your company’s business objectives in China?”

Comments:

- “Yes. During the meetings and business activities, I acquired extensive and valuable resources in China, especially the connection with several business leaders and potential target markets I’m interested in.”
- “I met a number of people that will in future help our company in the pursuit of business in China and Hong Kong.”

Post-Mission Survey Results

- **Mission generates business opportunities:**

Business opportunities identified as a direct outcome of the meetings/events/tours that took place during the Mission:

Post-Mission Survey Results

- **Mission facilities business opportunities:**

100% of surveyed participants rated the overall effectiveness of the Trade Mission in facilitating project discussions/opportunities among delegation members and with other GTA companies as either “Extremely Effective” or “Effective”.

Comments:

- *“We all live in a busy world. Spending 2 weeks together...gives us opportunity to explore common business interests and to find ways to collaborate.”*
- *“There were a number of people on the Mission that I will look forward to doing business with in the future.”*

Post-Mission Survey Results

- **Mission worth attending:**

17 out of 18 surveyed participants answered “yes” to the question
“Overall, given the outcome, was attending the Mission worth the investment in time and money?”

Comments:

- *“Very much so! This was a very valuable opportunity, and will help us develop a number of business opportunities that would not have been able to develop otherwise.”*
- *“I would say it is totally worth to invest my time and small fortune on it.”*



Post-Mission Survey Results

- Delegates will participate again:

17 out of 18 surveyed participants answered “YES” to the question

“Would you participate again in Markham’s future China Trade Missions? If so, why?”

Comments:

- *“Every time I attended this mission, I could always meet new people and fresh my mind to adapt this fluctuate business environment.”*
- *“As a global business based in Markham, China presents one of the largest potential markets in terms of consumers as well as joint research and development platform.”*

- “I was very impressed by the organization of the trip. Thanks again to all those who made it happen!”
- “The Mission was well organized in acknowledgment of the various cities visited.”
- “Stay at one city longer.”
- “If we could stay longer in China that would be great.”
- “The agenda was extremely tight. I would have appreciated more downtime built into the agenda to allow me to see the country and attend to work related matters back home.”
- “More communication before the missions in order to have more ideas collected and shared.”
- “Tight schedule in each city.”
- “More time in southern part of China (such as Shenzhen, Hong Kong) and Shanghai.”

- Markham to name “Wuhan Avenue”.
- Support Nanhai Chinese Opera Culture Festival and Food Festival organized by Nanhai District (Canada) Association, October, 2016.
- Markham Economic Development Staff to follow up on CleNET relocation.
- Markham Economic Development Staff to respond to follow up requests by potential investors.
- Recommendation: Markham to participate in Hong Kong Trade and Development Council Canadian Mission to Hong Kong for the “Belt and Road Summit” in May, 2016.
