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


The Nodal Study

- Identified 350 companies able to provoke new office space
- Interviewed 40 major employers
- Identified 27 existing & potential nodes which have 76% of the region's 216M sq. ft. of office space
- 5 Critical Trends & Issues


We learned that no single location will do.

- Each node has a unique set of conditions
- 40 key decision makers:
No place in the region that is ‘hot’ or ‘desirable’
- We built it – will they come?



This is where employers think growth will occur.

- Majority of growth is dependent on 3 clusters
- Account for 48% of all the office space in the Region




The Region is growing.

- GTHA expected to grow by 3.5 million people over the next 25 years
- At least 50% of new jobs likely to be office jobs
- The Region will need up to 100M sq. ft. of new office space
- Equivalent to 40 First Canadian Places

The Ridership Forecast Study

- Complex challenge
- Working with a single line of growth in the Region
- Allocating growth to transit nodes means reducing growth in non-transit nodes
- Collaboration on the data with GTAA, Mississauga, BILD, and York Region



The Ridership Forecast Study

- Fine grain analysis
- Greater accuracy with ridership forecasting, two way travel
- Improves the analysis of both RER/ST and VIVA


