Summary of Management Review	 Presentation and supporting documentation provided to Top Management covered all required items identified in the Drinking Water Quality Management Standard and procedure. Top Management reviewed information from January 1 to June 30, 2018.
Deficiencies Identified	No deficiencies were identified at this meeting.
Decisions Made	 The Operational Plan will be recommended to Council for approval and endorsement. Review how other municipalities approve products used in their drinking water system. Confirm the number of dead-ends in the City. Discussions of the Langstaff plan should include Markham District Energy (MDE) to identify opportunities to streamline work. A summary of hydrant inspection issues should be reported in the management review.
Action Items	 Follow-up on action items from previous management reviews - Waterworks Product Review Committee Staff to review how other municipalities approve products. Follow-up on action items from previous management reviews – Deadends Briefing Notes Staff to add quantities of dead ends to the Dead ends Memo. Operational Performance – Watermain Breaks Staff to contact Bruce Ander of MDE to see if Langstaff watermain replacement can be planned in conjunction with new MDE piping installation. Operational Performance – Preventative Maintenance Staff to improve how hydrant inspection findings are reported by including the number of follow ups required.
