Notice of Decision

to Approve an Amendment to the Official Plan of the City of Markham

The Regional Municipality of York is the approval authority for this Official Plan Amendment. This notice of decision is given in accordance with Section 17(35) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13. The decision of The Regional Municipality of York is to **APPROVE** Amendment No. 17 to the Official Plan (2014, as amended) of the City of Markham.

Lands Subject to the Amendment:

Municipality: City of Markham

Location: Amendment applies City-wide (see Key Map)

Purpose and effect of the Amendment:

The purpose of OPA 17 is to provide:

- a) specific use policies for "shared housing" in the form of a rooming house; and
- b) a definition for "short term accommodation" and "principle residence".

The Amendment is based on the findings and recommendations included in City staff reports regarding Phase 3A of the City of Markham's comprehensive zoning by-law review. The City is proposing to regulate "shared housing" in the form of a rooming house and short term accommodation by defining and not permitting the uses as of right in the City's zoning by-law.

This Amendment introduces new specific use policies for "shared housing" in the form of a rooming house in the Official Plan to provide guidance to Council when considering a site specific development application for zoning approval to permit a rooming house. This Amendment also introduces new definitions for "short term accommodation" and "principle residence" in the Official Plan.

Who may appeal:

If applicable, only individuals, corporations or public bodies may appeal a decision of the approval authority to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal ("Tribunal"). A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or the group on its behalf.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the plan was adopted, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the council or, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

When and how you may appeal:

The last day for filing an appeal is no later than 4:30 pm on August 21, 2018 and it must be received in writing. A notice of appeal may not be sent by email. A notice of appeal must:

- 3. be accompanied by the fee required by the Tribunal and a fee of \$500.00 payable to The Regional Municipality of York for preparing the record to be submitted to the Tribunal.
