SUBJECT:	Proposed 2018 User Fee, Permit and Fine Increases
<b>PREPARED BY:</b>	Andrea Tang, Senior Manager, Financial Planning

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the report dated November 6, 2017 entitled "Proposed 2018 User Fee, Permit and Fine Increases" be received; and

That the 2018 user fee, permit and fine increases and their respective effective dates as outlined on Appendix A be approved; and

That Staff be authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to this resolution.

#### **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this report is to obtain Council approval for additional 2018 user fee, permit and fine increases ("user fee increases") and their respective effective dates as outlined on Appendix A.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

On June 1, 2017, Bill 148, The Fair Workplaces, Better Jobs Act, was introduced by the Provincial Government which has an impact on part-time, casual, temporary and seasonal employees.

In October, Bill 148 received second reading and is currently with the Standing Committee for public consultation. Some of the proposed amendments are as follows:

- 1. Minimum wage increase (effective January 1, 2018): increase from the current rate of \$11.60/hour to \$14.00/hour, and further increase from \$14.00/hour to \$15.00/hour (effective January 1, 2019);
- 2. Personal emergency leave (effective January 1, 2018): maintain 10 personal emergency leave days per year of which two days will be paid if the employee has been employed for one week or longer;
- 3. Vacation entitlement increase (effective January 1, 2018): minimum vacation entitlement will increase from two to three weeks per year for employees with 5 or more years of service;
- 4. Statutory holiday pay (effective January 1, 2018): calculation changes for public holiday pay;
- 5. Equal pay for equal work (effective April 1, 2018): equal pay for part-time, temporary, casual and seasonal employees who perform the same job as full-time employees;
- 6. Standby pay (effective January 1, 2019 for Non-union Staff and January 1, 2020 for Union Staff): wages equal to the employee's regular rate for three hours of work if the employee is on call to work and the employee is:
  - Not required to work;
  - Is required to work but works less than three hours.

Staff calculated the 2018 annualized financial impact of \$2.50M resulting from the Bill 148 amendments as outlined above.

Staff presented the financial implications of \$2.50M, equivalent to a tax rate increase of 1.71%, to the Budget Committee on October 10, 2017.

Staff were directed to provide more details on Bill 148 and show options to address the financial impact of \$2.50M at a future Budget Committee meeting including user fee, permit and fine increases.

This report outlines the three options that were presented to Budget Committee on October 27, 2017 and the process undertaken by Staff to review and analyze potential user fees increases to fund the Bill 148 costs.

### **OPTIONS/DISCUSSIONS:**

Staff identified the following options to fund the financial impact of \$2.50M:

- 1. Fund 100% of \$2.50M through a tax rate increase, equivalent to 1.71% as presented at the October 10, 2017 Budget Committee;
- 2. Fund 100% of \$2.50M through user fee increases;
- 3. Fund 27% of \$2.50M or \$0.68M through tax rate increase, equivalent to a tax rate increase of 0.46%, and the remaining 73% or \$1.82M be funded from increase in certain user fees.

As part of the due diligence process, all departments undertook a review of user fees, and permit and fine rates to determine the City's position using other municipalities as comparators. Staff focused on rates that were significantly lower than our direct municipal comparators and assessed the impact of increasing rates on users and volume.

Based on Budget Committee's recommendation that the tax rate increase be under 3.00%, Staff proposed and Budget Committee endorsed Option 3 whereby \$0.68k will be funded from a 0.46% tax rate increase, and the remaining \$1.82M would be funded from an increase in user fees. With the additional 0.46% tax rate increase, the total tax rate increase is 2.90%.

Staff identified user fee increases and provided samples of the major fee increases.

Appendix A provides a full listing of the 2018 user fees impacted by the proposed increases as outlined in the report.

Below is a summary of the proposed fee increases by department which includes a Council approved annual user fee increase where applicable based on the greater of Consumer Price Index (CPI) or the CUPE settlement.

### **Recreation**

The 2018 base rate includes the 2017 approved rate + 2.83% (CPI 1.90% + utilities 0.02% + aquatic wages 0.91%). Increases outlined in this report are in addition to the 2018 base rate noted above.

The approach undertaken by Recreation Staff was to not impact programs such as DROP IN and limit the increase on children (learn to programs) and seniors that allow for the greatest benefit to the community based on cost and accessibility.

The recommended changes to fees are generally in facility booking, where based on comparison to other municipalities in our Region, the City has capacity to increase. As well, ice rates are now aligned with Richmond Hill's 2017 approved rates.

The City's "Learn To" programs - aquatics, sports, camps and general interest user fees are at the top of the range in the Region or at least within the top of the percentile and will only be increased by 1.30%.

### **Operations**

The 2018 base rate for sportsfields includes the 2017 approved rate + 2.83% (CPI 1.9% + utilities 0.02% + aquatics wages 0.91%). Proposed increases are in addition to the 2018 base rate.

The sportsfield rates are now aligned with Richmond Hill's 2017 approved rates.

Road occupancy and road closure rates will be increased to match the highest rate amongst our municipal comparators.

### Waste

A new \$5.00 administration fee will be applied when damaged bins are exchanged for new ones.

### <u>Library</u>

The 2018 base rate includes the 2017 approved rate + 1.92% (CPI 1.9% + utilities 0.02%).

Meeting room rates will be increased to align with Markham Community Centres and program rates will be increased to align with Markham Recreation programs.

#### <u>Fire</u>

Liquor licence inspection fees will be increased based on comparison with 6 fire departments.

#### **Culture (Museum, Art Gallery and Theatre)**

The 2018 base rate includes the 2017 approved rate + 1.92% (CPI 1.9% + utilities 0.02%). Proposed increases are in addition to the 2018 base rate.

Rate increases for Theatre have been benchmarked against Richmond Hill and Oakville.

### **Legislative Services**

Parking fines will be increased, where applicable, to match the highest rate amongst our municipal comparators (i.e. Toronto, Mississauga, Aurora).

### **Financial Services**

The mortgage administration fee will be increased to match the highest rate amongst our municipal comparators (i.e. Vaughan).

### Sustainability & Asset Management

Rates for service connection engineering drawings are either being introduced or increased to match to the highest rate amongst our municipal comparators.

### FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The 2018 annualized financial impact from Bill 148 totals \$2.50M. Budget Committee endorsed Option 3 whereby \$0.68M of the \$2.50M will be funded from a 0.46% tax rate increase, and the remaining \$1.82M will be funded from user fee increases as outlined in Appendix A. The proposed 2018 tax rate increase is currently at 2.90% which is comprised of a City controlled tax rate increase of 2.44% and an additional 0.46% tax rate increase to partially address the Bill 148 impact.

The remaining impact of \$1.82M will be funded from user fee increases as outlined in Appendix A. User fee increases will be implemented January 1, 2018 where possible. The annualized amount of \$1.82M will not be fully realized in 2018 as some user fees are tied to existing contracts; the proposed user fee increases will be applied upon expiry of existing contracts. Therefore, \$1.25M of the \$1.82M will be realized in 2018 and the shortfall of \$0.57M will be funded from the Ramp-up Reserve.
