1)	Call to Order	The Varley-McKay Art Foundation of Markham convened at 5:10 p.m. with Terrence Pochmurski presiding as Chair. The Chair invited members to introduce themselves to the

	Events	is taking place in the next two weeks – November 9th. Santo Natale is heading up the event with Foundation staff and has asked that Board members each purchase a minimum of five	
	a. Vintages	tickets at \$75 per ticket. Wine expenses are higher than last year as the representative has	
		indicated that wine must be acquired in twelve bottles per case at an average cost of \$25 per	
		bottle, and there is no return for unopened bottles. The supplier indicated that additional	
		servers and wine specialists are not being provided this year and bartenders have been	

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	hired. Sixteen different wineries from California, Oregon and Washington states are being featured. It was suggested that future events of this nature might result in more revenue if the LCBO provides the vintage wines.	
b. Gala Celebrating Varley Twentieth Anniversary	At the Board's direction at the last meeting to hold one large fundraising event, the Development Officer reported on her investigations into a possible date and venue for the 2017 Gala celebrating the Varley Art Gallery's twentieth anniversary. Craig McOuat, John Ingram, Susan Gray and Santo Natale have volunteered to work with staff to plan this event and need to set a Chair. Also further to the discussions from the last meeting it was reported that the Mayor and Chris Bratty will meet with a Board representative on November 18 <sup>th</sup> to discuss possible Remington Group involvement.  The Development Officer was looking for direction and/or confirmation of the following from the Board:	
	<ul> <li>Date: If October is the preferred month, the Board needs to decide whether Thursday, Friday or Saturday works best. The Development Officer will check availability for those days for suitable venues for mid-October, 2017</li> <li>Venue: To date Angus Glen and the Hilton have been canvassed. It was agreed that the Crystal Palace and Le Parc, and any other venue with capacity of 500 or more be investigated for availability for possible dates in October</li> <li>Theme: A direction on possible theme is required for the 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Gala. Board members were asked to email one or two suggestions to the Development Officer prior to the November Board meeting.</li> </ul>	Francesca  All Board Members
	<ul> <li>Budget: Given the investigations to date, it was suggested that a possible attendance of 350 people would require a budget of approximately \$50,000</li> <li>Sponsors: Sammy Lee indicated that he may have a corporate 'title' sponsor willing to cover the proposed amount of \$50,000 for the event. He indicated that he will respond to the Chair and / or Director of the Varley Art Gallery within the next week or so. The Board extended their pleasure at this possibility and thanked Sammy for</li> </ul>	Sammy

Staff will work up a sponsorship package as soon as possible.</li> <li>Ticket Prices – The Board suggested that the ticket prices should reflect the level of the event and that \$75 - 100 be considered. However, it was agreed that a cost analysis to determine a break even plus fifteen percent would also be investigated for further discussion by the Board.</li> <li>Auction – it was agreed that a silent auction would be held, but that a live auction may be difficult given the type of event.</li> </ul>	
5) Anniversary Publication	To celebrate the Varley Art Gallery's twentieth anniversary in 2017 a year long exhibition featuring the Gallery's most cherished works by F.H. Varley is planned. It has been proposed that a book be published which would highlight 20 to 25 of the most important works, list the entire collection of Varley works, celebrate the history of the Gallery and the generosity of the Foundation and other donors. Niamh O'Laoghaire, Director of the Varley Art Gallery presented a draft budget for the Board to review. Sid Karsh confirmed that the terms of the Education Fund can contribute to the costs for the publication.
