> <u>Unionville Theatre Company – Carlene Flynn</u>

- started here in 1987 with 35 to 40 members
- 70% of the cast must be youths
- focus for recruiting kids is York Region
- get survey feedback every three years re the types of shows we do
- are not registered but are not-for-profit; do have corporate sponsors
- in February, 2016, we're doing "The Little Mermaid"; do 8 shows per run
- have 100 to 150 volunteers who work the shows
- also supported by the Markham Concert Band
- have a lot of community partners
- do find the rental rates extremely high; eventually won't be able to cover expenses
- some frustration with theatre staff extremely understaffed
- look at how to work better together to sell more tickets
