6.0 PRIORITY ITEMS – PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION

6.1 <u>Flato Markham Theatre Community Partners</u>

Markham Little Theatre – Terry Browne

- all volunteer community theatre with between 80 and 90 members
- not-for-profit registered charity
- our 50th Anniversary; also 30th Anniversary at Markham Theatre
- great event; pleased to be involved
- relocated to theatre from Markham High School
- in fact, used to have a member on the theatre board
- 4 plays per year; 120 over the years; talking about reducing to 3 per year
- subscription base of 720
- fill rate is about 50% per show
- rehearsal home is "Backstage" location at Markham Museum
- audience base has eroded over the last 15 years; a universal problem in theatres
- have only been mildly successful in getting sponsors
- don't want to raise ticket prices but have been told don't charge enough
- more aware of costs than ever; discuss lower rental rates
- budget for a performance is \$12,500
- human resources are limited
- extremely pleased to have a home at FMT
- also extremely pleased with staff; invaluable, friendly and helpful
- have been discussions in the past re renting out workshop, however, were safety issues
- had some discussions with Unionville Theatre Company re sharing subscription base but talks fell through; same result with Markham Youth Theatre and Markville Secondary School
- other groups tend to do musicals; royalties cost a fortune
- other groups charge their members a fee to appear
- would love to partner with someone; would help us both
- more publicity and advertising? are promoted in the theatre season brochure; also web site, e-mail blasts, posters
- re changing demographics, have attracted a number of Asian members; some stay, some don't
- shows based on English drawing room comedy; don't necessarily appeal to other cultures
- try to get more contemporary plays but then the older audience doesn't come

6.2 <u>Flato Markham Theatre Education Partners</u>

<u>Unionville High School – Maureen Weaver, Jeff Wrigglesworth, Dawn</u> <u>Adams</u>

- construction of theatre and high school was a partnership between the York Region District School Board and the town
- school was originally intended to be on Carlton Road at the now William Berczy Public School site
- currently in the process of updating the original agreement
- UHS had the first arts program in the board; originally Arts York but now Arts Unionville
- is curriculum-based, with music, drama, dance and visual arts
- technical department buildings the sets; students and teachers
- do use the theatre quite a lot; biggest user is the music department
- also host events
- visual arts show in the lobby but want to become more involved
- relationship with theatre second to none; really unique situation and a very important relationship
- staff sets it apart
- lucky to have a professional venue rather than having to use the school
- wish to make a public acknowledgement of the school staff
- mindboggling how the 4 areas can come together and produce performances, fascinated by skill level
- visions of department heads and teachers are large and inclusive
- students start at Grade 9
- elementary school students invited to watch, dance department does outreach programs
- kids understand the benefits of arts in general
- Showtime (started 1987) 100 kids signed up for the course
- set design, orchestra, actors, etc.
- has a community reputation as being worthwhile
- part of that reputation is the association with FMT
- parents also contribute to the cost; support by buying tickets
- very proud that 3,000 have graduated from the arts program since 1985
- kids want to be hands-on; sing, dance, act
- working on minimum standards re planned day use of the theatre
