Markhamizing costs include items such as graphics (Markham logo), lighting, shelving / racking, fire extinguishers, first aid kit, and corrosion protection

### **Item #1**

Full size cargo vans have gone through a transformation to a new European design. These vans have evolved to unibodys vs body on truck frames. These new designed vans are lighter, and they provide better fuel economy, payload, safety features and cargo capacity, however this design change has increased the cost of the full size cargo van models.

Due to the budget shortfall, Staff contacted the City's rental company to determine if it is feasible to purchase used rental vehicles. The rental company had 2015 full size cargo vans that had been used for one rental season, however, the price was \$100 per unit higher than the unit cost of a new 2016 Ford Transit as recommended under this award.

### **Summary**

The award of \$440,871.58 for the replacement of 17 vehicles and the associated "Markhamizing" cost of \$29,400.00, totaling \$470,271.58 will be funded from the

various accounts as identified within the Financial Considerations section of this report with available budget of \$421,164.29.

The net shortfall in the amount of \$49,107.29 (\$470,271.58-\$421,164.29) will be funded from the Waterworks Capital Contingency in the amount of \$50,458.13 and the remaining surplus amount of \$1,350.84 will be returned to the original funding source.
