The meeting convened at 4:05 PM with Jim Sandiford in the Chair.

1. POST PARADE DISCUSSION

Jim Sandiford distributed the 2015 financial statement and it was noted that there was a \$5,130 net loss.

The Committee discussed the following relative to the Santa Claus Parade:

- Float entry fees were much lower than previous year
- Need to pursue more sponsorships for 2016
- Consider developing partnerships with large corporations in Markham (Town of Stouffville does this for their parade)
- Ensure float entry fees are received prior to the parade day
- Reach out to York Region school and private schools if they have bands that would be interested in being in the 2016 Santa Claus Parade
- Inquire if Air Cadets will volunteer
- Grand Marshall Jim will look into Jennifer Valentine from Breakfast Television
- Encourage all vehicles in the parade play Christmas music

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- More barricades required at the entrances to the museum
- Consider having the permit and traffic management plan in place one month prior to the Parade so that small businesses can be provided with a "pass"
- Float entry application include a section where non-profit companies can entry their non profit charitable number

2. PAID AND AUXILIARY OFFICERS

Nikolas Dimitrakopoulas, York Region Police advised the Committee that the on-duty Police Officers will need to be limited for the 2016 Santa Claus Parade.

The following was discussed with respect staging and traffic management:

- Regional Roads such as Highway 7 and 16th Avenue investigating if York Region can alleviate some of their rules
- With fewer paid officers the Committee will need to consider alternative staging areas, alternative parade routes, etc.
- Councillor Campbell will investigate if the driveway at the cemetery can be used for staging some of the vehicles
