The York University Markham Campus Committee convened at 4:13 pm with Mayor Frank Scarpitti in the Chair.

# 1. PRESENTATION BY YORK UNIVERSITY

Bud Purves, York University representative addressed the Committee and provided some brief opening remarks regarding the York University Markham Campus.

Greg delivered a PowerPoint presentation relative to the York University Markham Campus. The presentation included an update, description of the site, timelines, next steps and post funding announcement.

The Committee discussed the following with respect to the two proposed York University Campus buildings:

- Phase I building will be 12 storeys in height; with a 3 storey building in foreground (podium)
- Phase II building will be 15 storeys in height; with a 4 storey building in foreground (podium)
- Parking discussions will continue with City staff
- Buildings will include elevators size and quantity of elevators to be finalized at a later date
- Potential to connect the two buildings
- Importance of external connectivity between the buildings and surrounding community
- Include bus stops and people with disabilities in future renderings

The Committee suggested that staff consider the following in future discussions and/or negotiations with York University representatives:

- Ensure the site plan application complies with Markham's bird friendly standards
- Aim for a maximum transit modal split
- Potential for a future shared Library facility between Markham Libraries and York University
- Have their district heating and cooling energy provided by Markham District Energy
- Roadway between the Phase I York Campus building and Markham PanAm Centre ensure the local character is enhanced through good street design

The Committee thanked York University representatives for their presentation and suggested that the next presentation include the programs being offered at this campus.
