1. UPDATES:

a) Main Street Markham Environmental Assessment

The Environmental Assessment has been completed and plans can now move forward. This change has come after many years of deliberation.

b) Incoming Planning Applications

Mr. Hutcheson reviewed the recent planning applications including a demolition permit that was approved by Council for 15 Rouge Street.

c) Public Washrooms

Mr. Hutcheson reported that the project had been revised in an attempt to reduce costs. The tender has been released for new bids. contractors may not know of the project if they don't subscribe to "Bidtogo". Staff was asked to follow up on how the Town tenders these types of projects.

d) Budget Subcommittee – Keith Thirgood

The issue of the need for additional funding for the detailed design phase of the Main Street Markham Environmental Assessment Project was discussed. Mr. Hutcheson also reported that the funding and work plans for the next phase of the Main Street Interpretative Project needs to be discussed with the Interpretive Sub Committee. Diane Moore is to set up a meeting. The issues relate to whether we proceed with the design of a few interpretive panels at this time or whether we prepare a booklet.

Further work on the Tannary Pond Project cannot take place as a permit is needed because of the endangered species.
