A. Appointment of John Ryerson – Director of Culture

Ms. Linda Irvine, Manager of Parks and Open Spaces, reported that Brenda Librecz, Commissioner Community & Fire Services, has appointed John Ryerson as the Town of Markham's first Director of Culture of the newly created Department of Culture. Mr. Ryerson had served as Acting Director since April 2007 as the result of restructuring in the Recreation Services Department. The Markham Public Art Advisory Committee congratulates John Ryerson on this significant achievement. The members are happy that Mr. Ryerson is part of the committee and are looking forward to his leadership in developing cultural policy and the Public Art Plan.

B. Committee Budget

Ms. Linda Irvine, Manager of Parks and Open Spaces, reported that Town of Markham Council did include a total of \$60,000 funding for the Markham Public Art Advisory Committee in the current Town of Markham budget. The Markham Public Art Advisory Committee appreciates the commitment that Town of Markham Council has made to the importance of art to a community and its reaffirmation of the committee's efforts to make art easily accessible to the Markham community at large.

It was agreed that Committee members will research and think about potential art events. The May and June Committee meetings will focus on developing project ideas and planning initiatives for the coming year.
