# 3. ART ON ICE EVENT

The Committee discussed the event which took place February 14-16, 2009 and made these observations:

- The event was well attended with 3000 in attendance throughout the three days, 1400 attended on the Family Day holiday Monday February 16th;
- Attendees showed much enthusiasm for the sculptures and children enjoyed the ice painting walls;
- Committee member Alina Tarbhai designed a brochure which was distributed to Town of Markham residents attending this event; it was instrumental in increasing their awareness of the Committee and its efforts;
- On behalf of Chair Matthew Korchinski, Committee members and volunteers were thanked for the tremendous effort they put forth to make the Art on Ice event a success;
- Chair Matthew Korchinski will review with the ice supplier the quality of ice sculptures and their positioning to better fill the available space;
- For future events, the Committee will endeavour to better schedule Committee members and volunteers during event hours and have on hand adequate supplies of hot chocolate and cups.

#### A. Municipal Public Art Plan

# 5. NEW BUSINESS

#### A. Proposed Park Signage

Ms. Linda Irvine, Manager of Parks and Open Spaces, presented draft designs and colour schemes of park signage for committee members to review. She is hoping to give the signs a contemporary "look" with clean modern lines but maintain a "heritage" feel through the use of conservative colours.

Committee members offered the following feedback:

- The concept was well received; it was felt that quality signs might foster increased respect by residents for the parks
- Including the park name and address were considered good ideas
- Green was the favourite colour chosen (over blue and beige) although there
  was some question as to whether green would blend in too well with grass and
  trees
- Suggestions included enlarging the Town of Markham logo and adding information about park amenities

# **B.** Fire Hydrant Painting

Ms. Judi McIntyre proposed an idea to paint the likenesses of dogs on a number of fire hydrants throughout the Town of Markham. The idea might have a broad appeal with residents and make art easily accessible.

# C. Planning

Ms. Linda Irvine, Manager of Parks and Open Spaces, recommended that the Committee develop project ideas and plans on a timely basis to allow time for the projects to be submitted to Town of Markham Council for approval.
